Within the context of the commemoration of the 500 anniversary of the discovery of America - Meeting of two Worlds - the Consulates Generals of Latin America and the Caribbean, have the honor to offer to the people of Hong Kong an ensemble of art works that through its plurality, reflects the mixture of its autochthonous origins and european traditions.
